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## Responsible Use Policy Grades 3-5

Saigon South International School believes that all students should have access to technology when they act in a responsible, efficient, courteous and legal manner.

Furthermore, Internet access and other online services, available to students and teachers, offer a multitude of global resources. Our goal in providing these services is to enhance the educational development of our students.

Acceptable use of technology applies to all technology-based devices maintained by the school and/or personal technology-based devices used during school hours on school property.

The following are our agreements about the use of technology at Saigon South International School.

Using the ICT equipment correctly and responsibly is very important.

I agree:

- 1. use the ICT equipment carefully.**
- 2. use the computer and the Internet only for school approved activities. I will only use the programs and websites that my teachers have approved.**
- 3. keep my password a secret.**
- 4. not tamper with or damage the hardware, software or the network.**
- 5. tell my teacher if I read or see something on the computer that makes me feel uncomfortable.**
- 6. never use the ICT equipment to be hurtful to others. I will not view, send or display inappropriate messages or images.**
- 7. print only with permission.**
- 8. access only my own files or my own folders.**
- 9. obey copyright laws.**

I understand that if I do not follow these rules, I might not be able to use the ICT equipment at school.

# Laptop Loaner Program

## Available to:

SSIS Students grade 4- grade 12

## Lending periods

Laptops may be loaned for up to **10 school days**. Under extenuating circumstances, and with parent communication, the loan period may be renewed/extended.

## Procedure

In the event of damage:

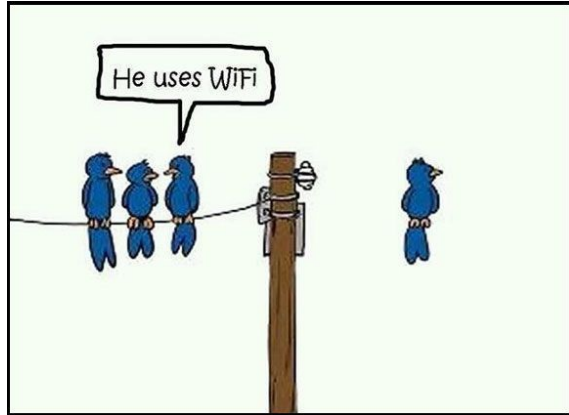
- Contact a repair center, submit the device and get an estimate of the time for repairs to be completed
- Complete the attached Laptop Loan Agreement and submit it to the ICT Department
- If available, a laptop will be prepared and signed out to the student (laptop + charger)
- Devices are available on a first come first served basis.
- Upon check-out and check-in, the device will be examined with the student to ensure all parts are operational.
- A deposit of **4,000,000 VND** is required at the time of the loan. A **rental fee of 100,000 VND** will be charged for each day of use. Payments are made at the business office.

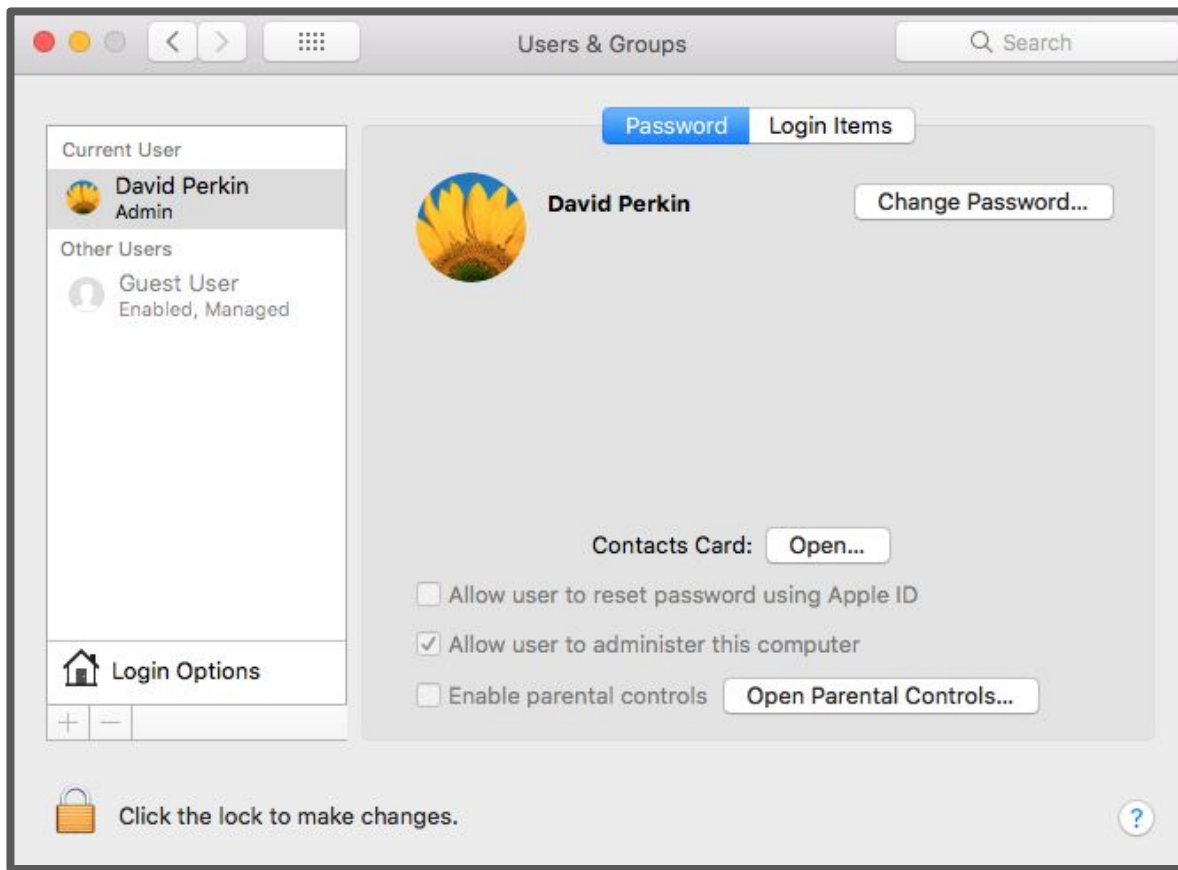

Creating a Student Apple ID (managed by parents) without a credit card

1. If your child doesn't have a personal email account, create a new one (E.g. Gmail <http://gmail.com/>). Alternatively you could also use your child's SSIS Gmail account.
2. Install (<http://www.apple.com/itunes/download/>) or open iTunes on your Mac or PC. You could also do this on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.
3. Click the iTunes Store button on the top middle part of the screen.

### Setting Limits:

- Set time limit per day for total screen time, and gradually allow the child more control over how they allocate that time.
- Set a specific time, or set of times, when the computer can be used.
- No computer use after a certain time.
- No technology at the dinner table.

### Developing Time Management:

- Daily work schedule planning
- Use a kitchen timer to help students understand how long they've been online. Set a reasonable amount of time, and put the computer away afterwards. It only takes a few times with this technique before the amount of time becomes routine.

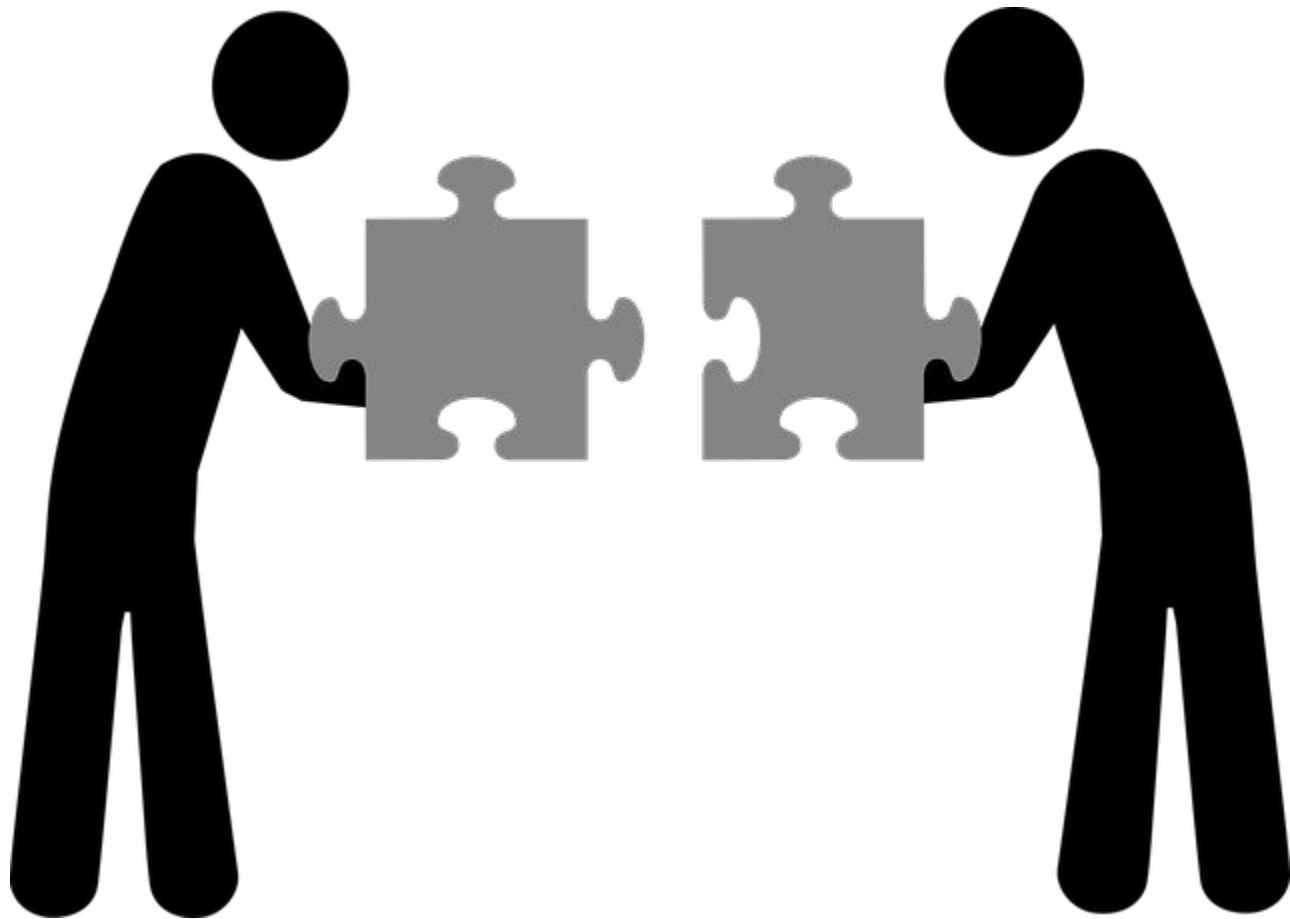

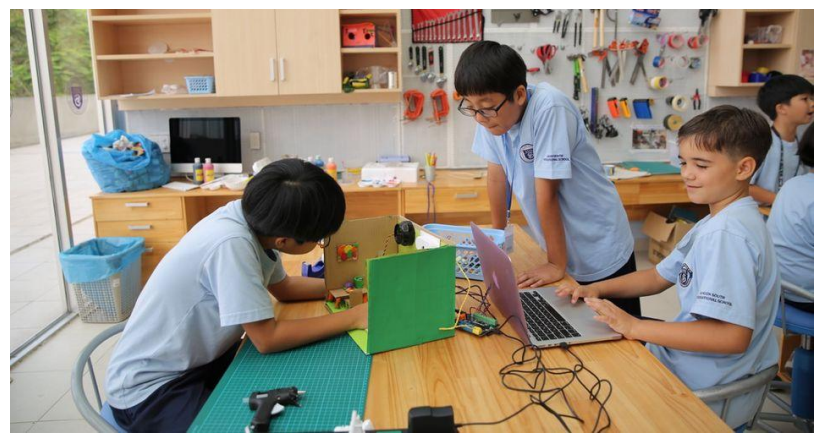
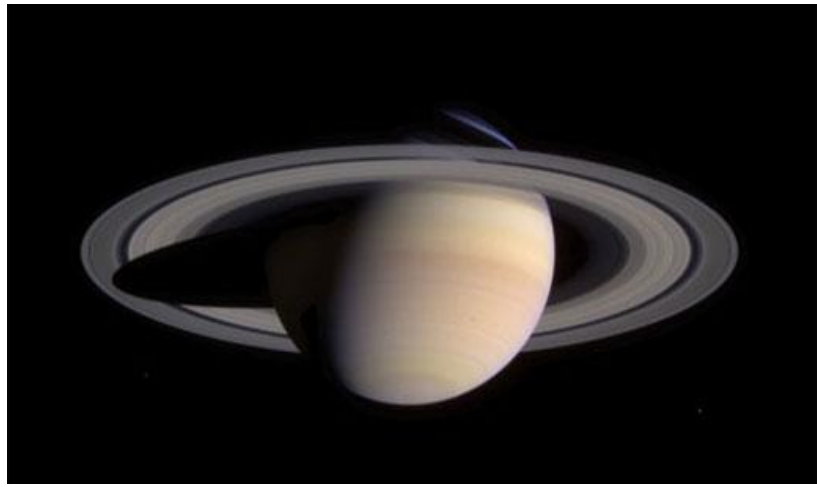
