YOU WILL BE WEARING YOUR SCHOOL UNIFORM TOP
WHILE TRAVELING TO & FROM MUI NE

When we arrive at Mui Ne, you can change into other clothes
& put your uniform away to wear again on the day we depart for HCMC.

DO NOT BRING YOUR LAPTOP.

- 1 small suitcase for clothes (this will be transported under the bus to/from Mui Ne)
- 1 small backpack for on-the-go items (this will be on the bus w/you daily & during activities)

- 2 pairs of comfortable sneakers/hiking shoes (closed toe) - may get dirty or wet
- 1 pair sandals/flip flops for evening times
- 1 pair of closed toe water shoes/shoes that can get wet - no flip flops/crocs

- 6-7 t-shirts (2 per day - one for activities, one for other times during the day)
- 2 long sleeved shirts
- 1 sweatshirt (lightweight)

- 3-4 pairs of shorts
- 1-2 pair lightweight pants (for evenings & hiking)

- 4 pair of underwear (minimum)
- 4 pair of socks (minimum)
- 2 pajamas (we will stay 4 nights)
- 1 swimming suit
- 1 raincoat/poncho
- 1 hat

- 1 towel to take to the beach activities
- Bathroom kit - toothbrush, toothpaste, personal items
- Deodorant!
- 2-3 plastic bags for wet/dirty clothes
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent/insect bite cream
- Hand sanitizer - small container
- Sunglasses
- Some money (500,000 VND maximum)
- 1 flashlight/torch

- Any personal medication - **these items will go to Mr. Freil**

Optional

- Cards/games (small, easy to carry)
- Book to read
- Rash guard/swim shirt
- Healthy snacks (**no nuts please**)
- Travel alarm clock

CELL PHONES (**ALSO OPTIONAL**) will be allowed on the bus trip to Mui Ne. *Phones will be collected before we arrive at the hotel and stored in a hotel safe.* Teachers will return cell phones to students for the return bus trip to HCMC. **Bring your phone at your own risk.**
