# WHAT TO PACK CHECKLIST (put your name on all items)

NOTE: Comfortable and sturdy shoes are required for this trip. Sandals and flip flops do not offer enough protection or support for trekking/hiking, but are allowed in the hotel and swimming areas.

DO NOT bring single strap packs for use as a daypack/bus carry-on. Bring a small or medium sized backpack (with two straps) to use when we are not in the hotel.
